The first BCIA Training Awards Ceremony got off to a great start. As you can see from the photographs, the event was well supported and the award winners proved to be worthy recipients.

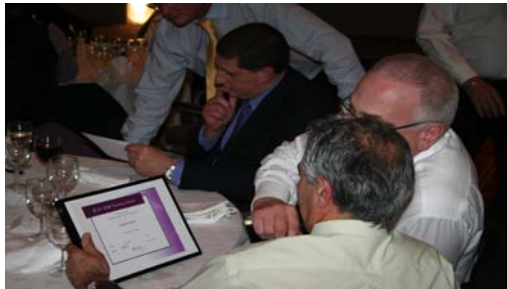
